

Deacon Robert Wilson

The fabric of life is woven together in patterns that display love, hope, and faith. And the greatest of these is love. So, on Sunday, January 23, 1949, the love of Mr. Eugene Wilson and Mrs. Olena J. Wilson welcomed the fourth of what would grow to become eight children into the family. For this son, they chose the name Robert which means "Bright Fame". Such a name conveys the pleasant personality of a cordial person who has a good sense of humor and loves people. Indeed, Robert's fame was bright; and he was able to illuminate truth and to bring truth to the light as he let his light shine on those around him.

After graduating from Lucy Laney High School in 1967, Robert joined the United States Air Force in 1969 and served honorably for eight years. He was later employed at East Central Regional Hospital as a Procurement Officer, where he remained for thirty-five years until his retirement in 2009.

In the intervening years, Robert Wilson joined Mount Calvary Baptist Church in 1959 and remained a devoted and faithful member. He was the Church School Department of Youth Superintendent and Youth Class Teacher, a graduate of Discipleship 1&2 of the Soul Winning Society Circle, a member of January Birth Month Fellowship Group, Vice-President of F.H. Hart Male Chorus, and he was also affiliated with the Heavenly Choir. He was ordained as a Deacon on September 3, 1985. He remained a dedicated and dutiful Deacon for thirty-two years and simultaneously continued his affiliations with the Church School. He was an original founder of the 39/27 Disciples, Inc. He served as Chaplain and Statistician, of this organization which is based on the Prayer of Jabez (1 Chronicles 4:10).

In 1978, Robert pledged his love to Mary Ann Kent, an aspiring nursing student from Rockmart, Georgia, whom he met while she was attending the Medical College of Georgia in Augusta. On January 20, 1979, they were united in the bonds of holy matrimony. To this union of thirty-eight years, family and friends have witnessed two hearts that says, "If I could hold a star for every time you've made me smile, the entire evening sky would be in the palm of my hand. What greater thing is there for two human souls, than to feel that they are joined for life - to strengthen each other in all labor, to rest on each other in all sorrow, to minister to each other in silent unspeakable memories at the moment of the last parting?"

Robert was greatly loved and will be greatly missed by all who knew him; for he was definitely, a husband, father, brother, uncle, brother-in-law, friend, and Christian who knew the Lord and loved the Lord with all his heart, soul and mind. Robert took time to share this "Good News" with others. Many souls have benefitted from an inspirational encounter with Robert. We learn something from everyone who passes through our lives.
