MRS. MARJORIE L. METZ, affectionally called "MADGE", was born in Trelawney, Jamaica on June 10, 1946, to the late Henry George Nathaniel Govern and Eulalee Mae Curtis.

She attended Falmouth (all age) School and Westwood Boarding School. After migrating to England for several years, she received schooling and was trained as a Registered Nurse. After moving to the United States, she retired from Beth Israel Hospital.

Madge and her late husband, Lloyd, loved Nesta's daughter, Andrea "Andie", since she was 3½ years old.
