The Obituary

On November 6, 2017, Deacon Paul Griffin, Sr., died at the age of 81 at the VA Hospital in Charleston, South Carolina. He was born on July 2, 1936 to the late Deacon Charlie Griffin, Sr. and Deaconess Janie Mae Brown Griffin.

Paul accepted Christ at an early age and was baptized at Mt. Transfiguration Baptist Church. Paul received his education in the Aiken County Public Schools. He was drafted into the US Army and was given an honourable discharged in 1963. Paul started working as a watch repairman in a small repair store in Bath, South Carolina. He went on to earn his Associate's degree at Orangeburg Calhoun Technical College. After graduation, Paul was hired at Sears & Roebuck and moved his family to Goose Creek, South Carolina. After the move to Goose Creek, Paul actively served as a Deacon at Royal Missionary Baptist Church.

Paul was married to the late Mamie Lou Curry Griffin, and to this union they had five children: Brenda Lee (Marcus) Duffy, Paul (Lynda J.) Griffin, Jr., Martha Denise Griffin, Mary Ella Sweet and Rodney Griffin.
